

Lodz University of Technology invites you to take part in the PROM Project - “International scholarship exchange of PhD candidates and academic staff”

What is the aim of the Project?

The aim of the project is to increase international exchange of PhD candidates at [Lodz University of Technology](#) (TUL), and therefore, to improve quality and level of internationalization of third degree education, as well as to strengthen cooperation with foreign universities.

The Project is implemented by TUL in the framework of the PROM Programme “International scholarship exchange of PhD candidates and academic staff”, coordinated by the [Polish National Agency of Academic Exchange](#) and financed by the European Social Fund, Operational Programme Knowledge Education Development for 2014-2020.

What does the Project offer?

Within the 3rd call for applications, the Project offers **11 PhD candidates of foreign institutions** a possibility to conduct a short-term scientific visits (lasting from 5 to 30 days) to Lodz University of Technology.

Eligible **forms of education** to be implemented during the mobility are aimed at:

- active participation in a conference held abroad (including presenting, participating in a flash talk),
- obtaining materials for a PhD thesis/scientific article,
- participation in a summer/winter school (both as a student of the school and as a lecturer); the theme of the school programme must be closely connected to the topic of the PhD thesis and/or research undertaken,
- taking measurements with the use of unique equipment, including large research infrastructure unavailable (or not easily available) in Poland,
- participation in short forms of education, i.e. courses, workshops, professional or industrial internships, study visits
- participation in trainings (including training on entrepreneurship or implementation activities) execution of archival / library inquiries
- participation in brokerage meetings
- conducting teaching classes
- participation in preparation of an international grant application
- other short forms of education allowing to increase the competences of the Project Participant.

The objectives of the mobility should be closely related to the subject matter of the PhD thesis being carried out by the Candidate.

Who may participate in the Project?

The 3rd call for applications is open for a PhD Candidate of a foreign university, i.e. person pursuing doctoral programme in a country other than Poland (e.g. doctoral programme/PhD programme/another equivalent) in a scientific discipline corresponding to the third cycle of studies offered by Lodz University of Technology.

What is the deadline for applications?

The application process is carried out accordingly to the on-going procedure, until the pool of available funds is exhausted.

What are the financial rules for participation in the Project?

TUL will provide funds to each Participant for the following costs:

- flat-rate maintenance costs depending on the number of days of stay abroad, including 2 days of travel, and
- flat-rate travel costs (i.e. travel, insurance and a visa) depending on the distance (in km) in a straight line between the Participant's place of residence and the city of Lodz.
